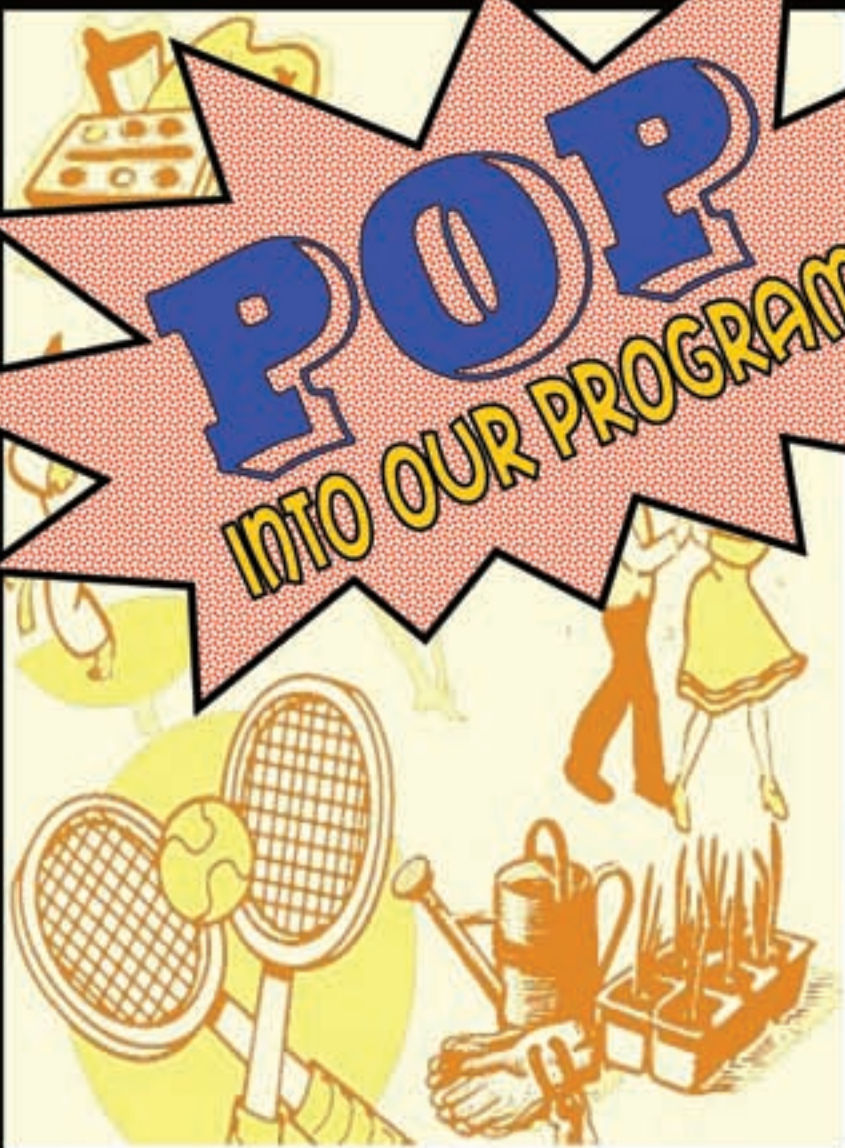

STAR PUPPYSM KINDERGARTEN



Make your puppy a STAR PuppySM. This course covers responsible pet ownership: teaching your puppy to meet people politely, walk nicely with you, come when called, sit and lie down when told, and to stay. It also includes exercises to make trips to the vet pleasant for you and tips on heading off common behavior problems. Health and grooming tips will be discussed. Limited enrollment ensures personal attention for you and your puppy. Puppies must be 4-9 months old, and up-to-date on their puppy shots. Bring vaccination record to first class. First class, 90 minutes, no puppies. Remainder of classes, 60 minutes, with puppies. So, puppies (*mixed breeds and purebreds*) who successfully complete the course qualify for an AKC certificate as a "STAR PuppySM". Instructor is an AKC Canine Good Citizen Evaluator.
